EV Charging Station Permit Fee Schedule

1. **Contractor Registration Fee:**
 - a. All electrical contractors installing EV charging stations shall register their license with the City prior to applying for permits. Registration shall be valid until the expiration date on the contractor or license. The contractor registration fee shall not be prorated.
 - i. EV charging station electrical contractor registration.....\$30.00
2. **Application Fee:**
 - a. Non-refundable application fee.....\$100.00
3. **Plan Review Fees**
 - a. Plan reviews are required for all level 2 (240V) and 3 (DCFC) chargers.
 - b. Building and electrical plan review fees will be at an hourly rate of \$90.00 per plan reviewer with a one-hour minimum for the following installations:
 - i. Two or more Type II chargers at one location.
 - ii. Bidirectional Type II charger with or without an energy storage system.
 - iii. Commercial Type III charger installation
 - c. Depending on the scope of the project the plan review may include reviews by the Planning, Fire, and Engineering Departments.
4. **EV Charging Station Permit Fees:**
 - a. The fees for EV charging station installations shall be as follows:
 - i. Type II charger, breaker, branch circuit per port.....\$180.00
 - ii. Bidirectional charger and equipment per port\$253.00
 - iii. Bidirectional charger and equipment with ESS\$323.00
 - iv. Type III charger installation per port \$180.00 plus fees per the Division 4 electrical fee schedule for additional equipment.
 - b. New or upgraded electrical service, panels, sub-panels feeders, etc. beyond listed above will require additional permit fees per the Division 4 electrical fee schedule.
5. **EV Charging Station Reinspection Fees:**
 - a. Per re-inspection\$90.00
6. **Cancellation of Permit**
 - a. Cancellation of a permit will require a written request to cancel. Once the request has been reviewed and approved, all fees shall be refunded except the application fee, 25 percent of the permit fee, \$90.00 per inspection that has occurred, the plan review fees, expired permit extension fees, and any fees by the City's consultants.
 - b. If a permit expires due to 180 days of inactivity there will be no refund of any fees.
