#### VILLAGE OF ROSCOMMON

Minutes of the August 9, 2021 Regular Council Meeting

President Michael Miller called the Regular Meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Members of the Council present: Michael Miller, Tony Medina, Angela Cook, and Heather Roemer. Maureen Ruddy live streamed from her home in the Village of Roscommon. Dan Fishel and Jared Osmond were absent and excused. Others present - Manager Ron Alden, and Clerk Frances Dawson, Tammy Menghini and Lance Cherven. Public present at the meeting were Kathy Pardo Carlson, JoAnne Lederman, Bonnie Odell, Mary Jane Sundquist, Mike Allen and Jerry Medina. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all and an Invocation was given by Trustee Tony Medina.

#### CONSENT AGENDA

Moved by Roemer, seconded by Medina, to accept the Consent Agenda with bills to be paid in the amount of \$16,254.30. Ayes: Miller, Medina, Ruddy, Cook, Roemer. Nays: None. The motion carried.

#### **REGULAR AGENDA**

Moved by Cook, seconded by Roemer, to approve the Regular Agenda with the addition of USDA Flies & Vandenbrink invoice totaling – Sewer \$55,611.49 and Water \$82030.36. Medina saying that he would like the addition of Agenda items more in line with the adopted process and Alden pointed out that this was a last minute addition. Ayes: Ruddy, Roemer, Cook, Medina, Miller. Nays: None. The motion carried.

#### MANAGER'S REPORT

Alden gave updates on:

Beachwood Café is now open and running well.

Thank you to the kids in the Summer Work Program – Katie Perterson, EN – Nathan Near, Madison McPherson, Crystal Moore. They did a great job, and we hope to have kids in the program next summer.

Food Distributions are going well – stats provided - numbers are down for the summer, but the volunteers are still showing up in great numbers to help. The next one is August 28, 2021 from 9:00 am to Noon.

Fall Household Hazard Waste Collection is Saturday, September 11, 2021 at the Roscommon County Road Commission.

The local Chambers of Commerce in the area have put together a book on local attractions and pertinent numbers for distribution.

There has been no update on the tree removal at Hiawatha. No tree removers have called back.

#### PUBLIC ACKNOWLEDEMENT ON REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

Pardo Carlson complimented and apologized to the construction crew for the USDA. She felt they did a great job of cleaning up when they were done and were very courteous.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Cook gave an update on the Marijuana Committee meeting. There is a first draft of the Ordinance by the committee that is now ready to go to the attorney and then it will come back for Village Council approval.

Cherven gave the USDA update -

The Division Street project will be paved and finished within this week or next.

The USDA is moving along. All water service has been restored to the new lines, with the exception of a section of water main that has to be totally replaced on George St. That should be started this week. Main Street will be getting paved along with Sixth, and Shelley, etc... On Main St. by the Sunny Spot there is some contamination in the soil that is being tested to see how extensive that is.

All paving should be done by Labor Day weekend and everything restored.

All Sewer work is done except for in front of Bob's Butcher Shop and they are waiting on parts – should be by the middle to the end of September and it should all be done.

After that the USDA crew will be out at the power plant doing the work that has to be done out there. Well houses should be done by the first of October – permitting that parts all come in. Meter software is already installed at the water tower and the plumber will be starting to install meters in the next couple of weeks.

Alden went through the billing process of the USDA.

Alden went through the Capital Improvement Plan that was adopted in 2017 concerning the Sidewalk replacement. It listed out the problem areas in town. With the new tractor the DPW is getting that will clean up a lot of the sidewalks and then the new sidewalks being built.

Motion to approve Flies & Vandenbrink USDA engineering for work done in June & July 2021 for \$137,641.85 by Roemer, seconded by Cook. Ayes: Ruddy, Cook, Roemer, Medina, Miller. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Motion to approve one high school senior student (18 years of age) with requirements from Village Attorney for honorary position for one year with DDA by Medina, seconded by Ruddy. Ayes: Roemer, Ruddy, Cook, Medina, Miller. Nays: none. Motion carried.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Presentation from Kathy Pardo Carlson for One Love Rescue for feral cat rescue in the Village of Roscommon for a donation of \$1,000.00. Roemer stated that donations to organizations were not permitted with taxpayer money. Carlson stated that this is a problem that is in the Village and affects the Village and is not a donation but a step to fixing the problem. The matter has been put on hold for further research.

Alden to set up a schedule for the 2022 Budget meetings and approval. Office and DPW will do a draft and run the adjustments by the Auditor and then bring it to Council at the October Regular Meeting. The Council will set a special meeting and public hearing so that the Budget can be finalized at the November Regular Meeting. If there are any issues, there is still December for any changes.

Update from Alden and Menghini on the Village of Roscommon web site. The amount of visitors and hits has been ordered from Revise, which they say will take 30 days. It was discussed back and forth what the merits/down sides of the web site and facebook.

#### DRAWING CHANGES

Upon additional sewer televising and exploration of the collection system, a segment of sewer main appears to be collapsed. The area is unable to be repaired by a trenchless method. Removal and replacement of the collapsed sewer is proposed on Lake Street near the intersection with Fifth Street. The sewer installation is shown on drawing C8 enclosed herein. The alignment of the existing sewer is also curved horizontally and to correct this issue a new manhole structure is proposed to straighten the alignment.

The proposed work is within the MDOT Right of Way and involves additional contractor coordination and protection of existing electrical utilities for traffic and pedestrian signals. An MDOT Right of Way permit and amended EGLE Part 41 permit will be obtained by F&V. The estimated quantities related to the installation are provided in the following table:

Other unit rate items that are affected shall be paid for by the actual units installed. For instance, if additional pavement removal and HMA placement is necessary, the cost will be reflected by the actual quantity of those unit rate items. 

#### DRAWING CHANGES

Upon additional sewer televising and exploration of the collection system, a segment of sewer main appears to be collapsed. The area is unable to be repaired by a trenchless method. Removal and replacement of the collapsed sewer is proposed on Lake Street near the intersection with Fifth Street. The sewer installation is shown on drawing C8 enclosed herein. The alignment of the existing sewer is also curved horizontally and to correct this issue a new manhole structure is proposed to straighten the alignment.

The proposed work is within the MDOT Right of Way and involves additional contractor coordination and protection of existing electrical utilities for traffic and pedestrian signals. 


#### Item No. 2 - Environmentally Impacted Soil - Sheley Street

Watermain installation was underway along Sheley Street south of the railroad and heading towards the intersection of Fifth Street. The personnel in charge of the operation experienced strong petroleum odor once the excavation extended near approximate station location 71+10. The strong odor persisted to approximate station location 70+60 where the crew installed an 8-inch valve and ceased the operation at that point.

This area of watermain installation was not originally suspected to be impacted by non-hazardous contaminants. However, after F&V recently contacting EGLE representatives and researched environmental mappers, a demolished gas station formerly known as Rays Auto Wash was located at the west/southwest corner of Sheley and Fifth Street (Facility ID: 00002588) that contains leaking underground storage tank(s). We assume this site is contributing to the odor and suspected contaminants.

Where the petroleum odor and suspected contaminants are located, ductile iron pipe (spec section 33 11 00 - 2.02.B.1) with flouroelastomer (FKM) gaskets are required. The PVC pipe that was previously installed in the area of contaminated soils must be removed and replaced with ductile iron pipe (approximately 50 ft.). We anticipate the soil will be impacted by contaminants for the watermain tie-in at Sheley Street and Fifth Street that has not been installed yet (approximately 60 ft.). Excavate, locate and repair unknown intrusion located in sanitary sewer near MH # 41. Once excavation began, the sanitary sewer and an unknown black plastic line were exposed. The black plastic line had been drilled through the existing sanitary sewer line, compromising the sewer and allowing infiltration. It was suspected that the unknown black line was a gas line. DTE was contacted, and Steve the resident for DTE arrived on site, he confirmed that the line was in fact a DTE owned line.

The compromised portion of the sanitary sewer was removed and replaced with a new SDR 35 pipe using 2 Ferncos to make the connections. The gas line was routed on top of the sanitary sewer line. The area was then backfilled, compacted and asphalt patch.


