DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Police

Mr. DePasquale reported for November 2020 the Police Department handled 464 calls for service. Officers handed out 613 “Patrolled Your Area Cards” and completed 766 community policing checks.

The Investigative Section Received twenty-seven (27) investigations for the month and closed all except for three (3) of them, two (2) of them were closed by arrest, one (1) PR call was made.

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The Police Chief received two (2) commendations/appreciations from residents, praising members of the Department for their dedication to duty.

Officers completed numerous on-line, Ohio Peace Officer training courses.

Fire

Mr. DePasquale reported for the month of November there were 133 EMS calls and 30 fire calls at Macedonia Station #1, 101 EMS calls and 14 fire calls at Sagamore Hills Station #2 and 58 EMS calls and 18 fire calls at Northfield Center Station #3. There was mutual aid in 10 times and out 2 times. There was a total of 356 calls for the month of November.

Zoning

Mr. Zaccardelli reported for the last month there was a total of 5 permits for homes on the Mottl property. Mottl Reserve is completely sold out. There was a total of 10 permits in the last month. There are 123 permits so far this year for a total of \$64,745.00, which is earmarked for capital improvement.

Heartridge Development is moving forward. We will post updates on our website as we receive them. There is a Heartridge Development schedule currently posted on our website. There is equipment on the property, they are currently moving dirt and getting their final inspections. Possibly sometime in early summer they will be putting in the first home.

Roads

The official count from the weather bureau on the December 1st snow storm was 14.2 inches of snow in the township. The road department did a great job even with two trucks down with major mechanical issues during the storm and numerous trees and branches blocking the roadways which had to be cleared before they could start plowing snow.

Fiscal Office

Ms. Steimle reported the Fiscal Officer's November 2020 report had a starting balance of \$7,967,213.42, plus receipts of \$223,610.38, minus expenditures of \$268,762.64 (which includes memo receipts of \$7,279.06 and pending warrant report in the amount of \$261,483.58) with an ending balance of \$7,922,061.16.

CITIZEN FORUM

Mike Appel, 1381 Ashford Glen, asked whether we had received the two new trucks. Mr. Schweikert replied not yet. Hopefully by the end of this month or the first of the year. Mr. DePasquale said everything has been backed up because of COVID. Mr. Appel also asked about our salt supply. Mr. DePasquale said there is enough salt.

Mr. Zaccardelli made a motion to have the yearly Organizational Meeting on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Schweikert commented this meeting is closed to the public by law because the board goes into Executive Session to discuss compensation, etc. Seconded by Mr. DePasquale.
