

## **SAGAMORE HILLS TOWNSHIP – SPECIAL**

**Thursday, August 12, 2021– media notified**

The special meeting was called to order by Mr. DePasquale at 9:00 a.m. The media was notified.

R/C: DePasquale-present; Schweikert-absent; Zaccardelli-present;  
Fiscal Officer Laura Steimle-present. Attorney Jeffrey Snell present.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the Macedonia Services Contract for dispatch, fire and emergency medical services.

The Board may transact any other business it deems necessary.

Mr. DePasquale asked whether everyone had an opportunity to look at the contract. Mr. DePasquale turned the meeting over to Mr. Snell.

Mr. Snell stated we are not yet ready to approve the fire contract. We are getting very close. There are still a few terms that we thought we would have been prepared for today. Macedonia council will be meeting today, but probably not discussing the contract. We don't need to go further on this item.

Mr. Snell said there is a second item that has come in starting August 3, 2021 that has moved rapidly the last few days and is called OneOhio. It is a proposed settlement with the opioids with the State of Ohio. Mr. Snell reviewed and summarized the proposed settlement.

There was a brief discussion.

Mr. Snell recommended the trustees opt in to this agreement. Based upon Mr. Snell's explanation, Mr. DePasquale made a motion that we opt in to the OneOhio program. Seconded by Mr. Zaccardelli. RC Vote: Mr. DePasquale-aye; Zaccardelli-aye.

Mr. Snell presented letters to the trustees to sign in support of the two projects on the Sagamore Hills Township greenspace. One letter was to Andrew Bishop, Restoration Manager of the Nature Conservancy and the other was to Ms. Santina Wortman, EPA, Great Lakes National Program Office. Mr. Snell gave a brief summary of the two projects. (Letters attached)

Mr. Zaccardelli asked Mr. Snell to give an explanation in regard to the mask mandates that was issued by the State Legislature. Mr. Snell gave a brief explanation.

Mr. DePasquale made a motion to adjourn at 9:16 a.m. Seconded by Mr. Zaccardelli.
