

SAGAMORE HILLS TOWNSHIP – SPECIAL

Monday, December 7, 2020– media notified

The special meeting was called to order by Mr. Schweikert. The media was notified.

R/C: DePasquale-present; Schweikert-present; Zaccardelli-present; Fiscal Officer Laura Steimle-present.

The purpose of the special meeting was to review zoning resolution recommendations from the Zoning Commission for Residential Chapter Three, Cluster Section 5.11 Accessory Structures. This is a follow up to the Public Hearing and Meeting of November 9, 2020. The Board will transact any other business it deems necessary.

Mr. Schweikert asked Dr. Koncal to speak on behalf of the zoning commission.

Dr. Koncal gave a brief summary regarding the zoning commission's discussions regarding accessory structures and the 1.5% rule that has been in the zoning resolution for years.

There was a discussion.

After a brief discussion the trustees agreed to include the 1.5% rule with the proposed recommendations to Cluster Section 5.11 in Section Three Residential District and one accessory structure not to exceed one-hundred ninety-five (195) square feet.

Mr. John Zaccardelli made a motion to **ADOPT RESOLUTION 20-75** to approve the proposed recommendations of the Zoning Commission for Section Three Residential District, Section 5.11 Accessory Structures, and to further include the 1.5% rule and one accessory structure not to exceed one-hundred ninety-five (195) square feet.

Seconded by Mr. DePasquale.

Mr. Zaccardelli shared an email he received from Mr. Clyde Witt, a township resident in Greenwood Village. Mr. Witt understands the park closes at dusk, but on December 21st there is a rare astronomical event that he would like to photograph from the park. He requested that we allow him and a few other people to be in the parking lot area only for about an hour past dusk. Mr. Zaccardelli said he and the chief were okay with this, and asked Paul and Dave what they thought. They also agreed. Mr. Witt will need to fill out an event form.

Mr. DePasquale said we need to purchase 800 radios and equipment for the fire station. Macedonia has done some upgrades to the 800 system in the amount of approximately \$600,000.

Mr. DePasquale made a motion to **ADOPT RESOLUTION 20-76** to purchase two 800 radios for a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00. Seconded by Mr. Schweikert.

Mr. DePasquale made a motion to adjourn at 9:16 a.m. Seconded by Mr. Zaccardelli.
