AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SCHWENKSVILLE LEVYING THE TAX RATES FOR THE YEAR 2021.

The Ordinance provides for the levy of a tax rate of 7.34 mills for General Purposes; .36 mills for Fire Protection Purposes; and .10 mills for Library Purposes. Total tax rate of 7.80 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

ORDINANCE NO. 404

**BOROUGH OF SCHWENKSVILLE
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SCHWENKSVILLE
LEVYING THE TAX RATES FOR THE YEAR 2021**

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough of Schwenksville that a tax be levied on all real estate property within the Borough subject to taxation for the Fiscal Year 2017 as follows:

Tax rate for General Purposes, the sum of 7.34 mills on each dollar assessed valuation.

Tax rate for Fire Protection purpose, the sum of .36 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Tax rate for Library purpose, the sum of .10 mills on each dollars of assessed valuation.

Any Ordinance, or part of Ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
