**MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION
FOR RATIFICATION OF THE REVISED MUNICIPAL WASTE
MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Act 101 of July 28, 1988, was enacted to empower and assign the duty of counties to develop and implement municipal waste management plans and other wise assure adequate capacity for municipal waste which is generated in their boundaries, and to empower and assign the duty to each municipality other than the county, to assure the proper and adequate transportation, collection and storage of municipal waste generated within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 101, Montgomery County has developed, duly adopted and implemented a municipal waste management plan for Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Act 101, the Commissioners of Montgomery County established a Municipal Waste Advisory Committee to review and update the existing municipal waste management plan; and


WHEREAS, the Municipal Waste Advisory Committee has developed a municipal waste management plan revision that addresses the availability of disposal capacity and support of municipal recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Montgomery County adopted the Plan revision on March 3, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Act 101 provides that the Municipal Waste Plan Revision may serve as the amended county policy with respect to municipal waste upon ratification by more than one-half of the municipalities representing more than one-half of the County=s 2010 population.


