A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE MONTCO 2040 IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE 2018 APPLICATION DUE MARCH 1, 2018 AND PLEDGING THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO MEET A 20% GRANT MATCH

**WHEREAS**, Montgomery County has established the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program as a competitive funding program to assist municipalities in implementing the goals of the county comprehensive plan, Montco 2040: A Shared Vision; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is accepting applications for projects that advance specific goals under either of the county comprehensive plan's three themes: Connecting Communities, Sustainable Places, and a Vibrant Economy; and

**WHEREAS**, A 2018 focus category is "Adaptation and Resiliency"; and

**WHEREAS**, applications and projects must meet all stated requirements within the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program Guidebook; and

**WHEREAS**, Schwenksville Borough wishes to obtain \$48,400(grant dollar request) from the Montco 2040 Implementation Grant Program to provide funding for the **Schwenksville Station Trail Improvement**; and

**WHEREAS**, Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy has agreed to partner with Schwenksville Borough to provide consulting services for the natural areas design, volunteers to construct the rain gardens and swales and to supply the native species plants at below retail prices; and

**WHEREAS**, Schwenksville Borough has agreed to provide the 20% required match estimated at \$9,680;

**NOW THERE FORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Borough Manager Anne W. Klepfer is hereby authorized to submit a 2018 Montco 2040 Implementation Grant for the Schwenksville Station Trail Improvement project and Borough Council hereby pledges to make the requisite matching funds available;


