A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MAYOR'S "MAKING A DIFFERENCE COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD"  
TO RECOGNIZE GOOD CITIZENSHIP AND HONOR PERSONS WHO ARE MAKING SIGNIFICANT  
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THEIR COMMUNITY THROUGH THEIR TIME, ACTIONS, TALENTS AND DEDICATION.

WHEREAS, the success and prosperity of Schwenksville Borough and its residents depend on the work  
and contributions of dedicated citizen volunteers; and

WHEREAS, Schwenksville Borough wishes to encourage and promote community service and good  
citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Schwenksville wishes to recognize individuals who serve as a role model for  
compassion and service and who continuously strive to improve the quality of life for all Schwenksville  
residents as well as helping those in need; and

WHEREAS, from time to time a volunteer exhibits such strong passion for community service and  
compassion for others that recognition is warranted and deserved;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor's "Making a Difference Community Service Award" program is hereby established.
2. Eligibility for the award shall be any community member nominated, brought to the Mayor's attention or observed by the Mayor of Schwenksville who in his/her opinion has donated their time, actions, talents and shown extraordinary dedication and compassion to others through community service and who has made a lasting or meaningful contribution to the Schwenksville Community.
3. The Award is given out by the Mayor of Schwenksville at his/her discretion from time to time without any regular nomination deadlines, award eligibility periods or obligation to make an award.
4. The "Making a Difference Community Service Award" recipient will be recognized by a Mayor's Proclamation presented to the recipient at a Regular Borough Council Meeting and will be listed on a Recipient Recognition Plaque to be displayed prominently at the new Borough Hall & Community Room located at 300 Main Street, Schwenksville, Pennsylvania.
