Whereas, Schwenksville Borough wishes to make specified amenities within Meadow Park and the Main Street Plaza available for reservation by individuals, groups or organizations; and

Whereas, Schwenksville Borough wishes to establish rules and regulations for use of Meadow Park and Main Street Plaza by the Public;

Meadow Park & Pavilion Rules

By order of Schwenksville Borough

Schwenksville Community Meadow Park and Pavilion Rules

1. Park hours shall be from sunrise to sunset or as expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
2. Motorized Vehicles permitted in designated parking areas only or as expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
3. Park resides in a floodplain, park your motorized vehicle at your own risk.
4. No alcoholic beverages unless expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
5. No person shall damage park property, including trees & plants; violators subject to fines and penalties.
6. No smoking or vaping in Meadow Park.
7. No swimming allowed.
8. No Motorized boats permitted to be launched from Meadow Park.
9. Boating and use of the Boat Ramp is at your own risk.
10. It shall be also unlawful and it is hereby prohibited for any person, persons, firm, corporation, or agent thereof, unnecessarily to **discharge** in, into or upon any street, highway, park, or any place in Schwenksville, any rifle, gun, pistol, revolver, air gun, cane, cannon, or any implement which impels with force a metal pellet of any kind, or other appliances, whether projecting or exploding any bullet, cartridge, blank cartridge, cap or otherwise in accordance with § 86-2 of the Schwenksville Borough Codified Code.
11. No fireworks on park property in accordance with § 86-1 of the Schwenksville Borough Codified Code.
12. Littering is prohibited, this includes dog/pet waste; violators subject to fines and penalties.
13. No Horses are permitted in Meadow Park
14. Schwenksville Borough reserves the right to close the park or park amenities at any time.
15. Permits are required to Reserve the Pavilion for non-public activities.
16. Permits are required for use of the Park for groups larger than ten (10) people and for organized activities or gatherings.
17. All Temporary Rules and Regulations mandated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, its representatives, or Schwenksville Borough that are currently in effect must be abided by or be subject to the fines and penalties listed below.

* **"Permitted"** shall mean a lawfully issued Permit has been applied for, reviewed and issued to a responsible party for use of Borough facilities subject to Rules and Regulations established by Schwenksville Borough.

ENFORCEMENT: Meadow Park is under Video Monitoring and enforcement is by Schwenksville Borough and/or its designees.

PENALTIES: Any person or person violating any of the provisions of these rules and regulations shall be guilty of a Summary Offence and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine payable to the borough, not to exceed \$1,000.00 and the cost of prosecution or to be imprisoned in the County jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

Main Street Plaza Rules

By order of Schwenksville Borough

Schwenksville Main Street Plaza Rules

1. Main Street Plaza hours shall be from sunrise to sunset or as expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
2. Motorized Vehicles permitted in designated parking areas only or as expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
3. The use of skateboards, roller skates, scooters or other recreational accessories deemed to be a nuisance or to cause damage to the Plaza is prohibited.
4. No alcoholic beverages unless expressly Permitted* by Schwenksville Borough.
5. No person shall damage the Main Street Plaza property, including trees & plants; violators subject to fines and penalties.
6. No smoking or vaping on the Plaza/Borough Property.
7. It shall be also unlawful and it is hereby prohibited for any person, persons, firm, corporation, or agent thereof, unnecessarily to discharge in, into or upon any street, highway, park, or any place in Schwenksville, any rifle, gun, pistol, revolver, air gun, cane, cannon, or any implement which impels with force a metal pellet of any kind, or other appliances, whether projecting or exploding any bullet, cartridge, blank cartridge, cap or otherwise in accordance with § 86-2 of the Schwenksville Borough Codified Code.
8. No fireworks on park property in accordance with § 86-1 of the Schwenksville Borough Codified Code.
