RESOLUTION No. 2021-04

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-12 and 2020-16, RE-AUTHORIZING/AMENDING APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY FOR A MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR SUMMIT AVENUE ROAD, STORWATER AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS AND REQUESTING A WAIVER OF THE MATCHING FUNDS REQUIREMENT.

WHEREAS, Schwenksville Borough Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-12 AND NO. 2020-16 authorizing application to the Department of Community and Economic Development and the Commonwealth Financing Authority for a Multimodal Transportation Improvement Grant for Summit Avenue with an estimated total project cost of \$752,711 and CFA Request of \$710,805.00; and

WHEREAS, SCHWENKSVILLE BOROUGH has since experienced fiscal setbacks and matching grant notifications resulting and a loss of revenue;

BE IT RESOLVED, that Schwenksville Borough of Montgomery County hereby requests a Multi-modal Transportation grant in the amount of \$710,805 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used to repair the roadway stormwater system, add roadway stormwater infrastructure, add pedestrian improvements and reconstruct Summit Avenue with a total estimated project cost of \$752,711;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Schwenksville Borough of Montgomery County hereby requests a waiver/reduction of the required matching funds to limit the expense to engineering costs for project inspection in excess of those permitted by the grant;
