Dear Residents & Friends,

We are both relieved and excited to notify you that PennDot will be milling Main Street/State Route 29 in Schwenksville on Sunday Night the 20th of October between 7 PM and 5AM.

PennDot's contractor Highway Materials Inc. notified the Borough that milling in the Borough will take one night and is scheduled for this Sunday evening. Highway Materials Inc. will post Main Street for **No Parking**. It is very important that all Main Street residents who customarily park on Main Street find alternative parking arrangements for Sunday night and the following Sunday night.

The paving crew will come through, also at night 7 PM to 5 AM, one week later, on October 27th. In between, utility crews will be adjusting manhole covers and storm drains during the hours of 9 AM to 3 PM.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation and patience while PennDot does their work.

Halloween Parade Information

The Annual Schwenksville Halloween Parade is scheduled for Thursday, October 24th. Sponsored by Schwenksville Borough and organized by Central Perkiomen Rotary Club, Pre-registration for entries is available at www.centralperkrotary.org.

Beginning November 5th, 2019, voters should report to Schwenksville Elementary School located at 55 Second Street to vote. Volunteers for the Election Board will be on-hand to direct and assist you.

Fall Street Sweeping

Fall Street Sweeping is scheduled for November 20th and 21st. Please note that the purpose of street sweeping is to clean dirt and gravel from the roadways and **not to vacuum up leaves.** The equipment is not intended to collect leaves. Leaf pick up can be scheduled with Whitetail Disposal at schwenksville@whitetaildisposal.com at no additional cost. Leaf waste must be bagged in paper, bio-degradable leaf waste bags available for purchase at Home Depot, Lowe's and hardware stores and placed out on the curb for collection.
