### New Website is Launched!



Schwenksville Borough applies for many grants to help us implement our capital improvement plans that include highly visible projects such as Main Street streetscaping and Meadow Park improvements as well as low visibility projects such as improvements to both what's in the ground (stormwater management infrastructure) as well as what's above ground - repairs to the road surface. ### **Meadow Park & the Perkiomen Trail**

Neither Meadow Park or the Perkiomen Trail closed during the Pandemic except for the normal rules about closing from Dusk to Dawn. Please practice social distancing and use common sense and come back later if it seems too crowded. Also, please use trash and recycling cans and report to us if they are full or over flowing at 610-287-7442. They are on a weekly schedule to be emptied but the increased use has created problems. We are adding new trash cans to help alleviate this problem.

It is unfortunate that the shared parking for the park and the trail is temporarily blocked by construction. We encourage visitors to use the boat ramp parking in the Meadow and to use on-street parking. Please be advised that the vacant former Gas Station property is private property not approved for parking of any sort and the vacant lot adjacent to the Park Entrance is private property as well. Contractors for the construction project have permission to park there.

Due to concerns for everyone's health, including members of the band as well as the public, we have cancelled the 2020 Summer Concert Series "Music in the Meadow". We cannot enforce attendance limits to groups of less than 25

### **Public Nuisance Complaints**

We have received a complaint that someone is riding dirt bikes are ATV's on public roadways during early morning hours and late evening hours. It is illegal to ride these vehicles on public roadways and the State Police should be notified at the time of the occurrence. Their response will depend on what higher priority calls they have and where their patrol cars are.

We have also received complaints about pet owners who are not picking up after their pets and disposing of the pet waste properly - in their own neighborhoods and on public property. Please be a responsible pet owner and be considerate of your neighbors and the public. There are pet waste bag dispensers at the County Information Kiosk by the park entrance and the Borough installed one in Meadow Park recently. Additional waste and recycling bins are also being installed at Meadow Park.

volunteerism.

**Activities Committee** - A committee assembled to plan community events and activities. Currently, the primary events are Community Day, and the Summer Concert Series. However, the Borough is interested in planning and scheduling new events and activities to benefit the community and welcomes fresh ideas and volunteers willing to see their idea through from concept to implementation.

### **Message from your Tax Collector**

During the Pandemic State of Emergency June and July office hours

As of 4/9/2020, Schwenksville Borough Council <u>voted</u> to extend the Face Value County/Borough Tax Due Date to July 31, 2020 (from June 30) to account for current pandemic personal hardships. Payments can either be dropped off at 140 Main St. Borough Hall in the front door mail slot or taken to the counter at the Schwenksville Post Office free of charge located on Centennial St. Payments dropped in any other mail receptacle must have postage.

Free drop off at the Post Office only applies to Counter Services during normal business hours. If you require a "Paid" Receipt, please include a SASE with your payment and the complete tax bill.

June and July office hours have been set.

### **Learn More About Stormwater Management**

Stormwater Management is the responsibility of everyone. The Borough is responsible to manage its Municipal Storm System - by cleaning out the stormwater pipes, repairing them when they fail and inspecting them in accordance with the MS4 permit. Please help us keep our water clean and safe by preventing contamination from entering the storm system, by keeping storm drains free of obstructions and by <u>reporting concerns</u>.
