JOINT CITY COUNCIL/CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MEETING
February 6, 2012

The joint City Council/Chamber of Commerce meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Lujan, Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez, and Mayor Grey.

Attending for the Chamber of Commerce were Boyd, Galvan, Hinton, Nelson, Rodriguez, Salazar, Tovar, Yribarren, and President Qualls.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, City Attorney Costanzo, the press, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

President Qualls explained and distributed a packet of materials to Council. Packet materials included background information on the Chamber and a summary of revenue and expenses. He then asked Council for input on areas the Chamber can improve on.

After discussion, it was the consensus of Council to bring back the following items at a later Council meeting for further review. The items included providing IT/phone/internet services and office space as an in-kind expense, the Christmas decoration loan, a new Business Improvement District (BID), and beautification/signage.

President Qualls thanked the Council for the opportunity to meet in joint session and invited Council to attend the Chamber's Annual Crab Feed.

The City Council and the Chamber Board then expressed their feeling that a joint meeting should be held at least annually.
