

**CITY OF SELMA
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
February 19, 2013**

The regular meeting of the Selma City Council was called to order at 6:01 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Robertson, Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez, and Mayor Grey.

CONSIDERATION AND NECESSARY ACTION ON ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF TITLE VI OF THE SELMA MUNICIPAL CODE, TO ADD SECTION 5 RELATING TO POSSESSION CONSUMPTION OR SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE SELMA ARTS CENTER
