WORKSHOP/PRE-COUNCIL MEETING

The Workshop/pre-Council meeting of the Selma City Council was called to order at 5:03 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Robertson, Mayor Grey. Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez arrived at 5:30 p.m.
