

**CITY OF SELMA
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
March 3, 2014**

The regular meeting of the Selma City Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Robertson, Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez, and Mayor Grey.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, City Attorney Costanzo, Financial Consultant Yribarren, Fire Captain Petersen, Police Chief Garner, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION: Council member Derr presented Council with a Facility Award from the California Parks and Recreation Society District VII for the Selma Arts Center.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS: Ms. Vicki Figlas, stepped forward and provided Council with a mural update, and an invitation to the upcoming ribbon cutting.

AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, AND 17 OF CHAPTER 1
OF TITLE 8 OF THE SELMA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO SOLID WASTE
AND RECYCLING – *public hearing and adoption:***

Council member Avalos seconded the motion, and the motion carried with the following vote:

Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez inquired on Shafer Park, the City Manager agreement, and a new sports complex.

Mayor Grey inquired on a recent wire theft and reported on upcoming events at the Arts Center.
