

CITY OF SELMA
PRE-COUNCIL MEETING
June 2, 2014

The pre-Council meeting of the Selma City Council was called to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Robertson, and Mayor Grey. Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez arrived at 5:16 p.m.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, City Attorney Costanzo, Financial Consultant Yribarren, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 5:02 p.m., Mayor Grey recessed the meeting into Executive Session to discuss the following: Conference with Labor Negotiator for the following Employee Organizations: Selma Police Officers Association, Selma Firefighter's Association (IAFF Local 3716), and Safety Mid-Management; Conference with Real Estate Negotiator regarding price and terms of payment for the Selma Manufacturing Complex (UpRight); and one case of pending litigation pursuant to Government Code Section 54956.9 California Water Service Company, CPUC General Rate Case No. 12-07-007.

The meeting reconvened at 6:15 p.m., with Mayor Grey announcing that Council has provided direction to the City Manager regarding labor negotiations and real estate negotiations, and that due to time constraints, the closed session would continue immediately following the Regular meeting to discuss the pending litigation case.
