WORKSHOP/PRE-COUNCIL MEETING
July 21, 2014

The Workshop/pre-Council meeting of the Selma City Council was called to order at 5:02 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Derr, Robertson, and Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, City Attorney Costanzo, Financial Consultant Yribarren, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PRESENTATIONS: Mr. Daniel Bond, Engineer for the City of Selma, stepped forward and presented Council with a PowerPoint presentation regarding the upcoming 2015-2016 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project options. After much discussion, it was the consensus of Council to direct staff to proceed with the application utilizing the storm drain option.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez recessed the meeting into Executive Session at 5:27p.m. to discuss the following: Public employment for the City Manager, 1 case of potential litigation; 1 case of pending litigation California Water Service Company, CPUC General Rate Case No. 12-07-007.

The meeting reconvened at 6:09 p.m., with City Attorney Costanzo declaring that as a result the executive session, Council will vote to add an item to the regular meeting agenda. Motion to add the consideration and necessary action and direction on the appointment of Ken Grey as the City Manager of the City of Selma was made by Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez and seconded by Council member Robertson. Motion carried unanimously.
