- Provide friendly and compassionate service
 - Needs Assessment
 - Assist in identifying creative solutions to address housing crisis
 - Provide referrals to shelter or triage centers, if available
 - Connect to resources available such as: food, clothing, public benefits, employment services
- * **Providers cannot guarantee Shelter, immediate housing or financial assistance**

How Services Are Provided

- Field Deployment to connect with Community Members in the field
- Educate Community Members with documentation recovery necessary for employment or living requirements
- Attempt to identify housing through Selma MAP Point

Data

- Collect Data on how many community members are connected with.
- Recently started collecting data on community members that declined access point engagement.

Homelessness Facts

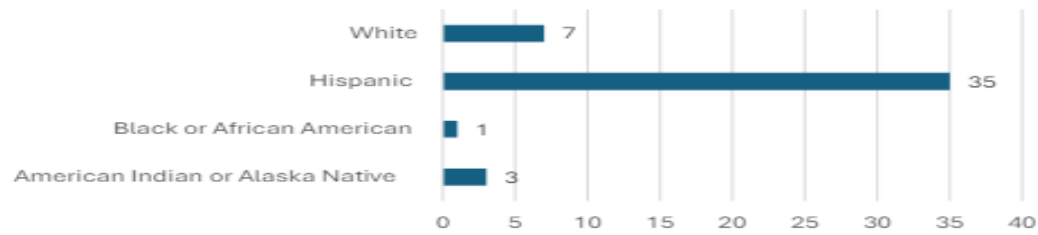
- There are community members which decline services that do not have mental health and or addiction problems.
- There is a significant shortage of available shelters.
- Majority of engagements identifies mental health or addiction problems.
- Increasing population of homeless that are working and unable to find housing.
- COVID funding has ran out which has reduced low income housing.

Interactions

- Community members are advised of services available
- Mental Health Clinicians response
- Enforcement when criminal activity present and or identified
- Educate and collaborate with property owners on illegal encampments.
- Work with Service Providers when feasible
 - (Uniform Law Enforcement could deter engagement)

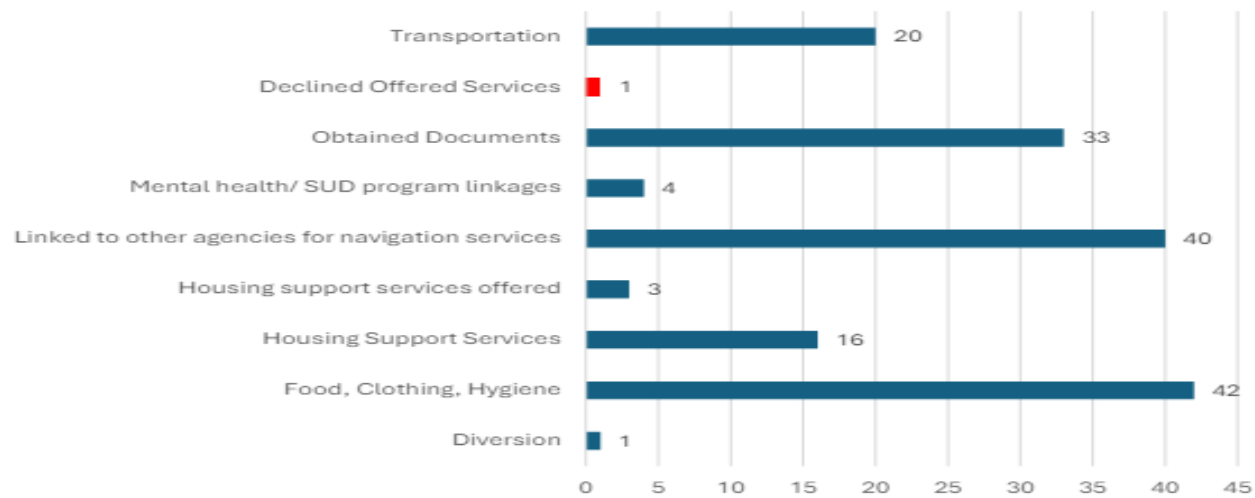
Race, N = 46



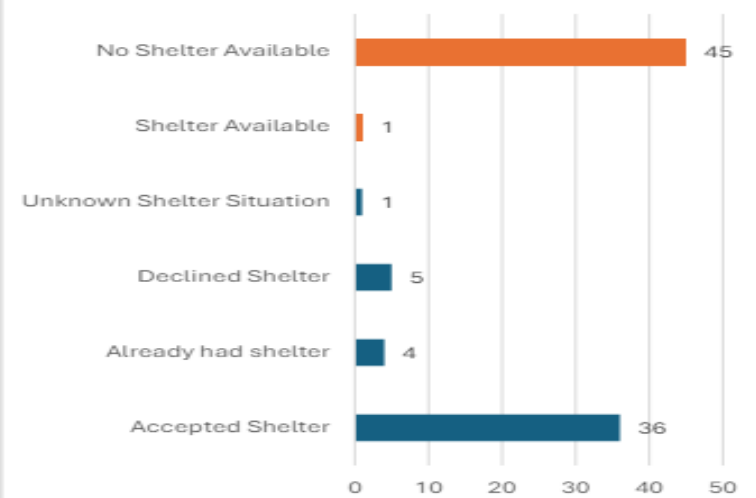
Primary language, N = 46
