SUBJECT: AGENDA REVIEW

Regular Business Agenda Items:

A. Little League Dugout Improvement Project: Selma Little League is requesting consideration to have on loan from the City of Selma, \$10,000.00 to assist with the reconstruction of the dugouts and bullpens at the Little League field. This project would improve the existing dugouts not only for Selma Little League, but also for the Challenger League in which they would be ADA compliant. This past August Selma Little League paid off their 10 year loan for new lighting that was completed five years ago. Staff is recommending the Commission consider approving this project and loan and recommending City Council approve. (Little League has is applying for a grant that would cover this project, but is looking at this option as a back-up if grant not approved). Little League would cover the additional funds for this project that is estimated to be approximately \$24,000.00.

B. Park Site Grant Visit: Staff will be providing an update to the Commission on the new Park Grant proposal at Rockwell Pond. On Tuesday, November 19, staff will be conducting a site visit. This by no means secures the grant funds, however, it does mean we qualified to the next round.

C. Peter Ringo Playground Grant: The playground equipment for Peter Ringo Park has been ordered and we have met on-site to finalize the removal of the existing equipment, installation and final ground cover. We should be receiving our equipment in approximately three weeks.

D. Recycling in Parks: This item was previously discussed and brought up by Commissioner Rodriguez. Updates and any new information obtained will be reported at the meeting.
