**Regular Business Agenda Items:**

**A. Food Distribution in Parks:** Staff has received several comments from residents on the number of food distribution in parks. Staff is presently evaluating other cities policies and procedures and will be providing a report at the meeting for discussion.

**B. Orange Avenue Canal:** Staff is presently working with Townsend Public Affairs on the submittal of a grant that would cover the canal from Stillman to Rose Avenue. This project would allow a path and landscaping to be placed above the covered portion of the canal and beautify the area. As previously discussed, the goal is to have a trail over the entire canal from Dinuba to East Front Street. Based on funding available this could fund the first phase.

**C. Peter Ringo Playground Grant:** Staff has been notified that the City of Selma will be receiving grant funds to assist with new playground equipment for Peter Ringo Park.
