AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL BY FIVE DISTRICTS, ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES AND IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF EACH DISTRICT, ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION ORDER OF EACH DISTRICT AND AMENDING TITLE 1 CHAPTER 11 TO THE SELMA MUNICIPAL CODE

A summary of that proposed ordinance is as follows:

Summary of Proposed Ordinance No. 2019-4

Ordinance No. 2019-4 concerns changing from an at-large city council method of election to a by-district city council method of election.

Pursuant to California Government Code Section 34886, the ordinance provides for the election of members of the City Council of the City of Selma by-district in five single-member districts, in furtherance of the purposes of the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (Chapter 1.5 (commencing with Section 14025) of Division 14 of the Elections Code) and to implement the guarantees of Section 7 of Article 1 and of Section of Article II of the California Constitution. The ordinance adopts the voting district map and the election date sequence for each of the districts.
