## CITY OF SELMA RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

On Thursday, March 19, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-33-20 calling for all California residents to stay in their homes, except for essential services. The City of Selma expects that our businesses and residents will comply with the measures outlined in the Governor's order, and we will follow the State's guidelines for enforcement.

Essential services listed in the order include:

1. Hospitals
2. Gas Stations
3. Pharmacies
4. Food: Grocery stores, farmers markets, food banks, convenience stores, restaurants with take out and/or delivery only
5. Banks
6. Laundromats/laundry service

The City of Selma and its partners will continue to provide essential services including:

1. Police and Fire
2. Transit
3. Public Utilities such as water, sewage, and trash pickup
