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**CITY OF SELMA
TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE
RULES & REGULATIONS**

The City of Selma encourages participation in Neighborhoods Block Parties and Special Events. Hopefully, citizens will join this program and gain the benefits of a stronger feeling of belonging and of community pride. Block parties should be held on private property whenever possible. If the party cannot be adequately handled on private property, the City will consider the temporary closing of public streets for holding block parties. However, we cannot shut down the entire street, as emergencies do occur. City activities must go on, and the mandate of the voters insists that government costs must be kept low. Therefore, certain procedures, restrictions and controls must be followed.

Temporary Street Closure permits will be required and will generally not be issued on:

1. Major streets.
 2. Any street which is not entirely within the City limits.
 3. Streets which provide major access for a subdivision, a church, hospital, public park, fire station, community center, or a business which is in operation during the hours of a block party or special event.
- A. **\$175** fee will be charged for each block party or special event street closure.
- B. Applications for Temporary Street Closure Permits shall be made in person or in writing as early as practical, but in no event less than five (5) working days' prior to the party or event.
- C. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be permitted to be served or consumed by any person in the public right-of-way. No illegal fireworks will be allowed at any time on or off the public right-of-way. Public right-of-way means all sidewalk and streets.
- D. Permittee will be held responsible for clean-up after the block party. It is suggested that several trash cans be placed in the block for collection of refuse.
- E. The hours of the block party street closure will be limited as approved by the City.
- F. The right of ingress and egress for every parcel of land must be maintained.
- G. Standard barricades must be placed across the streets at each intersection of the designated closures. The number of barricades needed will be determined by the Applicant at the time. The permittee will be held responsible for meeting this requirement. Barricades can be rented through the City for **\$10** each, plus a **\$35** deposit for each barricade. The deposit will be returned when each barricade is returned in good order. The permittee will have to pick up the barricades and return them to the Public Works Yard, 1325 Nebraska Avenue on the next workday after the block party. The permittee will also be responsible for any damage to the barricades. Barricades may also be rented from any company the permittee chooses.

- H. Barricades should be placed at the end of each street that is being closed in order to block the street from any through traffic, but one lane (approximately 20 feet) of the closed street(s) **must be kept free from any obstructions** in order for any emergency vehicles to have access to the closed street(s), as shown on the example below. The City will **not** authorize the prohibition of parking to meet this requirement. It is suggested that you request (in advance of the block party or special event), the cooperation of your neighbors to move their cars off the street.
- I. The permittee will be held responsible for removal of the barricades if emergency access is necessary.
- J. The City has a right to refuse or rescind any street closure at any time by the Selma Police Department, Selma Fire Department or any other city entity if any problem should occur.
- K. It is mandatory that **at least 80%** of the residences in the affected area give permission for this road closure. The City may at any time request the signatures of the residents in the area of the street closure indicating their approval for the road closure.
