Beer Board Meeting Minutes

Special Called Meeting: April 21, 2021

Place: Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road

Call to Order: Chairwoman Melissa York called the meeting to order at 6:01 PM.

Roll Call: City Recorder Lisa Smith called the roll, and the following Members were present: Member Adam Johnson, Member Lizzie Peoples, Chairwoman Melissa York, and Member Brett Fisher. Member Sandra Hughes was absent. Also, in attendance were City Attorney Ginger Shofner.

Adopt the Agenda: Member Fisher made a motion to approve the Agenda as submitted, Member Johnson seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.

Consideration of a motion to approve minutes: Chairwoman York ask if there were any changes to the Regular Meeting Minutes of October 14, 2020 and Special Called Meetings of December 28, 2020, January 7, 2021, and March 31, 2021. With no changes noted, Member Fisher made the motion to approve the minutes as requested, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Old Business: There was no Old Business.

New Business: Item A, the application to sell beer (off premises) by Shaileshkumar Patel, Matrudevoi, Inc., Depot Street Market, 700 E. Depot Street. City Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Shaileshkumar Patel come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:

Chairwoman York stated Question # 11 on the Application was left blank and Mr. Patel advised he was unaware of whom the former Beer Permit holder was as this address. City Recorder Smith advises she would check her records. Member Peoples ask if he intended to keep his other location on North Main open and he replied yes, he would operate both locations. With no further questions, Member Fisher made a motion to approve, Member Johnson seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous oral vote.

Item B, the application to sell beer (off premises) by Angela Kay Ingalls, Dolgencorp, LLC, Dollar General Store # 22652, 1903 S. Cannon Blvd. Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Angela Kay Ingalls come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:

Chairman York questioned the name on the application and Recorder Smith advised the application was completed by Dollar General's corporate office. **Member Peoples made a motion to approve the application, Member Fisher seconded, and the motion carried upon unanimous oral vote.**

Item C, the application to sell beer (off premises) by Aaron Klumb, Murphy Oil, USA, Inc., Murphy Oil USA #7803, 1890 North Main Street. Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Angela Kay Ingalls come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:



Chairman York questioned the first page of the Application is checked as if this is for a Special Event. Ms. Hamler advised it was an error this is for a full-time business. **Member Peoples made a motion to allow Ms. Hamler to amend her Application by marking off the event date, Member Fisher seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.** Chairman York then ask if the owner of the property knew she would be selling alcohol and City Attorney noted that Item 2 of the Lease specifically states no sale of beverages including alcohol. Ms. Hamler advised that the Lease meant until she received her license. Her landlord is good with her selling beer on the property. **Member Fisher then made a motion to approve the application, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried upon unanimous oral vote.**

Staff Reports: There were no reports from Staff.

With no further business to discuss **Member Fisher made a motion to adjourn, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.** Meeting adjourned at approximately 6:24 PM.
