

## Beer Board Meeting Minutes

**Regular Session Meeting:** May 12, 2021

**Place:** Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road

**Call to Order:** Chairwoman Melissa York called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

**Roll Call:** City Recorder Lisa Smith called the roll, and the following were present: Member Lizzie Peoples, Chairwoman Melissa York, and Member Brett Fisher. Member Sandra Hughes and Member Adam Johnson were absent. City Recorder Smith declared a quorum.

**Adopt the Agenda:** Member Fisher made a motion to approve the Agenda as submitted, Chairwoman York seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.

**Consideration of a motion to approve minutes:** Chairwoman York ask if there were any changes to the Regular Meeting Minutes of April 14, 2021 and Special Called Meetings of April 21, 2021. With no changes noted, Member Fisher made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

**Old Business:** There was no Old Business.

**New Business:** Item A, the application to sell beer (off premises & on premises) by Bassam Aklhanshli, Los Amigos Supermercado, 803 Deery Street, Shelbyville, Tennessee 37160. City Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Bassam Aklhanshli come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:


1. Have you received and reviewed a copy of the Beer Rules? Yes
2. Do you understand the Rules of which you have read? Yes
3. Do you have questions of any of the Rules listed? No
4. Have you received a copy of the Ordinance? Yes
5. Do you have any questions regarding the Ordinance? No
6. Have you ever held a Beer Permit before in Shelbyville or any other jurisdiction? Yes, 711 North Main Street.
7. Please describe your experience if any with beer sales. I currently work in a gas station.
8. Do you understand that underage sale of alcohol to minors is a violation of the law? Yes
9. Briefly describe your business establishment. Supermarket with a small kitchen to sell food.
10. Do you have any questions for the Beer Board? No
11. Are you aware of the responsible vendor training for off premises beer sales? Yes
12. Does the cash register software/system require birthdate for all beer sales? Yes
13. Are you the property owner for the location in which beer sales will take place? No
14. Do you as the applicant/agent realize that you are responsible as the beer permit holder for all employees' beer sales? Yes

Member Peoples asked the Applicant when they expected to open and how many employees he would have. He stated in the next two weeks and he planned to open with four (4) and add additional as needed. After requesting the time, the restaurant would start serving (8:00 AM), Member Fisher made a motion to approve, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous oral vote.

**Staff Reports:** City Recorder advised that the City Council current has an item up for discussion to limit the number of liquor stores in the City. She noted the Beer Board really does not have authority over Liquor Stores, that is a State function but wanted them to have the information if questions came up.

With no further business to discuss **Member Fisher made a motion to adjourn, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.** Meeting adjourned at approximately 6:08 PM.
