

Beer Board Meeting Minutes

Regular Session Meeting: August 11, 2021

Place: Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road

Call to Order: Chairwoman Melissa York called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Roll Call: City Recorder Lisa Smith called the roll, and the following were present: Member Lizzie Peoples, Chairwoman Melissa York, Member Adam Johnson, Member Joseph LaMattina and Member Brett Fisher. City Recorder Smith declared a quorum.

Adopt the Agenda: Member Fisher made a motion to approve the Agenda as submitted, Member Peoples seconded, and the motion carried unanimously by oral vote.

Consideration of a motion to approve minutes: Chairwoman York ask if there were any changes to the Regular Meeting Minutes of May 12, 2021, hearing none, Member Peoples made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, Member Fisher seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Old Business: There was no Old Business.

New Business: Item A, the application to sell beer (on premises) by Zocoyotzin Alexi Galindo-Ortiz, El Palacio, 503 S. Cannon Blvd., Shelbyville, Tennessee 37160. City Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Zocoyotzin Alexi Galindo-Ortiz come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:

Member Peoples asked the Applicant if he had considered the cash register software system requiring birthdates. Mr. Ortiz stated he had the software and was planning to implement it once he received the permit. He verified the location is next to Lander's Tire Shop. City Attorney Shofner advised the Board she had verified there was no problem issuing the permit to Mr. Ortiz based on the fact he is only 20 years old. Chairwoman York advised that Mr. Ortiz would be held responsible for all beer sales at the establishment, and she wanted to make sure he understood that. Member LaMattina stated some beer suppliers would provide signage concerning the age limit. With nothing further to discuss, Member Fisher made a motion to approve, Member LaMattina seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous oral vote.

Item B, the application to sell beer (on premises) by Rafael Covarrubias, Taco Feliz Mexican Food, 802 Union Street, Shelbyville, Tennessee 37160. City Recorder Smith requested the applicant, Rafael Covarrubias come forward and be sworn in. Chairwoman York ask the applicant the following questions:

Member Peoples asked where the business was located, and the Applicant stated 802 Union Street next to Moon and Taylor Barber Shop. With no other questions concerning the application, **Member Johnson made a motion to approve, Member Fisher seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous oral vote.**


