Subject: Sewer Rehab – American Rescue Funds

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**Description:** The City of Shelbyville is eligible for approximately \$2,967,622.59 in American Rescue Plan Funds. Little Hurricane Creek sewer shed needs replacement lines as the current lines are in excess of 50 years old. These funds would be used to address the critical needs and for the development of a comprehensive asset management plan to improve the operations/maintenance of the sewer and water system.

Shelbyville Power, Water and Sewer would be providing the 10% local match.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE AUTHORIZING  
SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF  
ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION FOR FUNDS THROUGH THE  
AMERICAN RESCUE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Shelbyville, Tennessee is eligible for funds under Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation Water Infrastructure Investment Program (American Rescue Funds); and

**WHEREAS**, there exists a need to address the critical needs identified on the Shelbyville scorecard including the replacement of older sewer lines and development of a comprehensive asset management plan; and

**WHEREAS**, sewer rehabilitation in the Little Hurricane Creek sewer shed will replace sewer lines in excess of 50 years; thereby, reducing infiltration/inflow in the Shelbyville Sewer System; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of comprehensive asset management plan will improve the operation/maintenance of the sewer and water systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Shelbyville and the Shelbyville Power, Water and Sewer System wishes to make an application for said project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT**

- (1) The Mayor be authorized and directed to execute and submit an application for funds to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.
- (2) The City of Shelbyville is eligible for \$2,967,622.59 in ARP funds. The Little Hurricane Creek Sewer Rehabilitation Project and Asset Management Plan's total cost is estimated to be \$3,297,358.43. The balance of \$329,735.84 or 10% in local matching contribution will be provided by the Shelbyville Power, Water, and Sewerage System.
- (2) The Mayor be authorized and directed to enter into all necessary agreements to receive and administer such funds.
