

Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes

Special Called Meeting: February 23, 2022

Place: Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road

Call to Order: 12:10 PM, Mayor Cartwright

Roll Call: The following were present: Councilmember William Christie, Councilmember Henry Feldhaus, Councilmember Marilyn Ewing, Councilmember Gary Haile, and Councilmember Rick Overcast. Also, in attendance were City Manager Josh Ray, City Recorder Lisa Smith, City Treasurer Kay Parker, and City Attorney Ginger Shofner. Councilmember Stephanie Isaacs was absent. Mayor Cartwright declared a quorum.

Adopt the Agenda: Mayor Cartwright ask for a motion to Adopt the Agenda, Councilmember Overcast made a motion to adopt the Agenda as submitted and Councilmember Christie seconded, the motion carried by unanimous oral vote.

Councilmember Ewing made a motion to allow the City Attorney to read captions only on Ordinances and Resolutions, Councilmember Haile seconded, and the motion carried unanimously on oral vote.

Councilmember Overcast made a motion to approve, Councilmember Haile seconded, and the motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

A Resolution to Annex certain Territory upon Written Consent of the Owners and to Incorporate the same Within the Boundaries of the City of Shelbyville, Tennessee. This Property is a 30.00 (+/-) Acre Tract of Land Located on the Westside of the 231 North Business Park and Referenced on Bedford County as Tract 2, Tax Map 050, Parcel 8.00, and Owned by Silicon Ranch Corporation. 
