

## City Council Special Called Workshop

The Shelbyville City Council met in a Special Called Workshop **December 14, 2022**, at the Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road. The meeting was called to order at 2:03 PM by Mayor Randy Carroll.

**Discussion of MTSU Project – Purpose, Scope and Intent:** Dr. McPhee gave an overall view of the current MTSU Aerospace program and the value in a partnership with Shelbyville by moving the Aeronautics campus to the Shelbyville Municipal Airport. He further advised that the intent is to develop the campus into the premier destination for Aeronautics study. Several other MTSU representatives spoke on the growth in the program advising they are anticipating over 1200 students in the next few years. Additional representatives advised MTSU's Board of Trustees is 100% behind the move to Shelbyville which will make a major contribution to the City. Councilmember Turnbow questioned the requirement for sewer and welcomed the open communications. Jason Reese, General Manager for Shelbyville Power, Water and Sewerage stated they fully support the project and will work with MTSU by developing a plan for future use.
