

City Council Special Called Workshop

The Shelbyville City Council met in a Special Called Workshop **Wednesday, February 23, 2022**, at the Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road. The meeting was called to order at 11:04 AM by Mayor Wallace Cartwright.

The following were present: Councilmember William Christie, Councilmember Marilyn Ewing, Councilmember Henry Feldhaus, Councilmember Gary Haile and Councilmember Rick Overcast. Councilmember Stephanie Isaacs was absent. Also, present were City Manager Josh Ray, City Attorney Ginger Bobo Shofner, City Recorder Lisa Smith, and City Treasurer Kay Parker.

Spectrum Fiber Presentation: City Manager Ray stated this is the final presentations on providing Fiber services for the City. Ray introduced Angie Sloan, Strategic Account Specialist for Government and Education with Spectrum Enterprise and turned the meeting over to her.

Sloan then went over the Spectrum presentation with assistance from Jacob Erwin, Managed Solutions Specialist and Cameron Branham, Sales Engineer. Sloan advised the Spectrum's focus was the strategic goals of the City and how to accomplish those goals. She stated Spectrum has four (4) total call centers in the US and they will be available to assist with any questions. She further noted that Spectrum is our current provider and is a member of NFTA which allows the City to work through a National Contract for pricing. Other items cover by Sloan and her team were the reliability of the network, the higher security of a managed network and the proposed set up of the network.

With nothing further to discuss Mayor Cartwright adjourned the meeting at approximately 12:09 PM.


