

City Council Special Called Workshop

The Shelbyville City Council met in a Special Called Workshop **Tuesday, February 22, 2022**, at the Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road. The meeting was called to order at 9:04 AM by Mayor Wallace Cartwright.

The following were present: Councilmember William Christie, Councilmember Marilyn Ewing, Councilmember Henry Feldhaus and Councilmember Rick Overcast. Councilmember Stephanie Isaacs, Councilmember Gary Haile, and City Attorney Ginger Shofner were absent. Also, present were City Manager Josh Ray, City Recorder Lisa Smith, and City Treasurer Kay Parker.

United Communications Fiber Presentation: City Manager Ray stated this is the first of two presentations from providers of Fiber services for the City. The other presentation will be done tomorrow by Spectrum. Ray introduced Joe Marchesoni, Business Account Executive with United Communications and turned the meeting over to him.

Marchesoni then went over his presentation advising the objective was to provide fast internet service with a reliable network, minimize security risks, improve productivity, and save the City money. He reviewed his company and the services they can provide emphasizing that they are a local provider, and any issues will be handled locally. Additionally, the service will include all departments of the City, an upgraded telephone system, a digital television service at the Rec. Center and Fire Halls.

With nothing further to discuss Mayor Cartwright adjourned the meeting at approximately 10:01 AM.


