

The City is often required to clean up spills of concrete or gravel when we do not know who is responsible for them, or when we do know who is responsible but the company fails to clean up the material. Over the past year, this has become a more frequent occurrence. The City Council passed on first reading amendments to the Shelbyville Municipal Code to (1) make it clear that the spills of concrete or gravel are covered by the code, and (2) to provide for the charging of a clean-up fee if a company responsible for a spill fails to clean it up promptly. These changes will be final after third reading. Clean-up charges will be based on use of the street sweeper and manpower. The sweeper charge is \$48/hour, the operator and any employees will be charged at \$59.86/hour. Please advise your drivers to proceed with caution through our city limits, and take immediate action to clean up any spills. Your cooperation will be appreciated.
