

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-1102

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR CITIZEN MEMBERS OF THE SHELBYVILLE POWER, WATER & SEWERAGE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Shelbyville in Article XVII provides for a Utility Board; and

WHEREAS, the Power, Water, and Sewerage System of the City shall be under the jurisdiction, control and management of this Board; and


WHEREAS, the City Charter provides in Article XVII, Section 17-3(c) that compensation of citizen members serving on the Utility Board shall be fixed from time to time by Ordinance of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed in the public interest to establish such compensation by Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, TENNESSEE as follows:

- Section 1. That the individual Board members shall receive compensation each month for attendance at a meeting of \$50.00 for the Power System Board, \$50.00 for the Water System Board and \$50.00 for the Sewerage System Board, a total of \$150.00 per month.
- Section 2. That the individual Board members shall receive individual healthcare coverage paid for by Shelbyville Power, Water and Sewerage System.
- Section 3. That the Board members may receive reasonable and customary out-of-pocket expenses incurred in the respective performance of their duties, including attendance at seminars, conferences or associated meetings. The System may incur this expense directly, rather than on a reimbursement basis in accordance with the adopted travel and training policy.
- Section 4. That the City Councilmember and the City Manager shall receive no additional compensation while serving as a member of this Utility Board, be it in salary or benefits.
- Section 5. That this Ordinance shall go into effect fifteen (15) days following its passage on second reading.


