

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-111D

AN ORDINANCE (As Amended) OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE TO SET THE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Shelbyville in Article III, Section 3-1 provides that the governing body of the City of Shelbyville be comprised of seven (7) members including a Mayor and six (6) City Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides in Article III, Section 3-7 that the salary of the Mayor shall be ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,800.00) per annum, payable monthly, and the salary of councilmembers shall be seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800.00) per annum, payable monthly.

WHEREAS, the City Charter further provides in Article III, Section 3-7 that the compensation of the Mayor and City Councilmembers may be set from time to time by Ordinance; provided however that no ordinance increasing the salary of the Mayor or Councilmembers shall become effective until the date of the commencement of a new term of the Mayor or Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed in the public interest to establish such compensation by Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, TENNESSEE as follows:

- Section 1. That the compensation of the Mayor of the City of Shelbyville shall be set to eighteen thousand (\$18,000.00) per annum, payable monthly.
- Section 2. That the compensation of the City Councilmembers of the City of Shelbyville shall be set to twelve thousand (\$12,000.00) per annum, payable monthly.
- Section 3. That the City of Shelbyville will provide, and cover the cost of, individual healthcare insurance to the Mayor and City Councilmembers, which will become available on the first day of the month immediately following the commencement of a new term.
- Section 4. That the Mayor and City Councilmembers may receive reasonable and customary out-of-pocket expenses incurred in the respective performance of their duties, including attendance at seminars, conferences or associated meetings. The Municipality may incur this expense directly, rather than on a reimbursement basis in accordance with the adopted travel and training policy.
- Section 5. That this Ordinance shall go into effect fifteen (15) days following passage by the Shelbyville City Council on second reading. The change in compensation will begin upon the commencement date of the new terms of the Mayor and each City

Councilmembers of the City of Shelbyville, same being January 2021 and January 2023. Additionally, individual healthcare insurance will become available on the first day of the month immediately following the commencement of the new terms.


