

**SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF HEALTH
MINUTES
March 16, 2021 AT 5:45 P.M.**

The Board of Health Quarterly meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on March 16, 2021 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mikulski at 5:45 p.m. and followed by a salute to the Flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Mikulski read the following statement: "Notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act by:

1. Posting a copy of the Annual Meeting Schedule on the bulletin board in the Municipal Complex and emailing a copy to the Central Record, Burlington County Times, and Courier Post, and all those requesting copies on March 10, 2021.
2. Posting a copy of the agenda on the bulletin board at the Municipal Complex.
3. Filing a copy of the agenda in the office of the Township Clerk at the Municipal Complex.
4. Forwarding a copy of the agenda to the Central Record, Burlington County Times, and Courier Post.
5. Forwarding a copy of the agenda to each person who has requested copies of the regular meeting schedule.

All of the above posting, filing and mailing have taken place on the 10th day of March, 2021."

A roll call confirmed those Committee members who were present, which included: Deputy Mayor Heston, Committeewoman Rossell, Committeeman Raftery and Mayor Mikulski. Committeeman Young was present remotely.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chairman Heston recommends vaccination for COVID. Continue to wear masks even after vaccination.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Heston reported COVID case numbers are leveling off and Southampton numbers remain low. State guidelines will change next week regarding restrictions. Mayor Mikulski encouraged anyone having difficulty obtaining a vaccination appointment to contact the Township for assistance.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

Chairman Heston opened the meeting to the public. No one wished to comment. The public portion was closed.
