

**SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF HEALTH
MINUTES
September 21, 2021 AT 5:45 P.M.**

The Board of Health Quarterly meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on September 21, 2021 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mikulski at 5:45 p.m. and followed by a salute to the Flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Mikulski read the following statement: "Notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act by:

1. Posting a copy of the Annual Meeting Schedule on the bulletin board in the Municipal Complex and emailing a copy to the Central Record, Burlington County Times, and Courier Post, and all those requesting copies on March 10, 2021.
2. Posting a copy of the agenda on the bulletin board at the Municipal Complex.
3. Filing a copy of the agenda in the office of the Township Clerk at the Municipal Complex.
4. Forwarding a copy of the agenda to the Central Record, Burlington County Times, and Courier Post.
5. Forwarding a copy of the agenda to each person who has requested copies of the regular meeting schedule.

All of the above posting, filing and mailing have taken place on the 16th day of September, 2021."

A roll call confirmed those Committee members who were present, which included: Chairman Heston, Committeeman Raftery, Committeewoman Rossell, and Mayor Mikulski. Committeeman Young was absent.

MINUTES: June 15, 2021

Mayor Mikulski made a motion to approve. Committeewoman Rossell seconded the motion. At the call of the roll Chairman Mayor Heston, Committeeman Raftery, Committeewoman Rossell, and Mayor Mikulski all voted in the affirmative.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Mikulski mentioned that Burlington County COVID tracking methods had changed which resulted in lower recorded COVID numbers for Southampton Township.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Heston reported that Burlington County will be holding flu vaccination clinics from October through January. He encouraged getting the flu shot.

Mayor Mikulski also noted that Burlington County has reopened their COVID testing site at the Emergency Services Training Center in Westampton.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

Chairman Heston opened the meeting to the public.

Bill Casian, 37 New Castle Drive, asked if the County would have the senior dose of the flu shot. Chairman Heston thought they most likely would have it.

No one else wished to comment. The public portion was closed.


