

**SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF HEALTH
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 18, 2022 AT 5:48 P.M.**

The regular meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on January 18, 2022 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Heston at 5:48 p.m.
