

**SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF HEALTH  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
September 20, 2022 AT 5:45 P.M.**

The regular meeting of the Southampton Township Committee was held on September 20, 2022 at the Robert L. Thompson Building, 5 Retreat Road, Southampton, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Heston at 5:45 p.m.

A roll call confirmed those Committee members who were present, which included: Chairman Heston, Committeeman Raftery, Deputy Mayor Rossell, Mayor Mikulski and Committeeman Young.

No comments were presented from the committee.


