 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Township of Southampton, New Jersey, is a rural township with a rich history of agriculture and open space. The Township's land preservation plan is designed to protect and enhance these resources for future generations. This plan identifies areas of high agricultural and scenic value and proposes to acquire these areas through various means, including public purchase, donation, and easement acquisition. The plan also identifies areas of existing public and private ownership that are currently preserved and should be maintained as such. The plan is based on a comprehensive study of the Township's land resources and is intended to provide a framework for future land acquisition and management decisions.

The plan is divided into several sections, each describing a different type of land preservation area. These include:

- Proposed Priority Farmland Acquisition:** Areas of high agricultural value that are currently in private ownership and are proposed to be acquired through public purchase or donation.
- Existing Publicly Held Open Space:** Areas of open space that are currently owned and managed by the Township or other public entities.
- Existing Preserved Farmland:** Areas of farmland that are currently preserved through various means, including easements and public ownership.
- Proposed Priority Open Space Acquisition:** Areas of open space that are currently in private ownership and are proposed to be acquired through public purchase or donation.

The plan also includes a detailed map of the Township showing the locations of these areas and the proposed acquisition boundaries. The map is color-coded to indicate the different types of land preservation areas. The plan is intended to provide a clear and concise overview of the Township's land preservation strategy and to serve as a guide for future land acquisition and management decisions.
