November 1 to February 28.

You must call 609 859-2736 to be placed on a pick up list.

No more than 10 bags of leaves will be picked up at a time.

If the leaves are in the trash,

your trash will NOT be picked up.

VINCENTOWN- RAILROAD STATION ON NORTH MAIN STREET

A vital part of the community in the late 1800's was the Vincentown branch of the Camden and Burlington Railroad Company. It was incorporated on March 15, 1861, and by 1864 the road ran from Ewansville to Vincentown, parallel to Route 206. The railroad was used both as transportation for folks working in various parts of Camden and Burlington County and for transportation of cattle, milk, and produce to market. A spur was built especially to haul the marl from the local marl pits to other parts of the state. The Railroad ran until 1928.



ACCEPTABLE:

- ✓ Plastic crates (milk/soda)
- Laundry baskets
- Plastic dish drainers
- Plastic drums, toters, and empty garbage cans all sizes
- Plastic buckets all sizes (no metal handles; no paint or spackle buckets)
- Plastic lawn furniture and pet carriers
- Plastic toys, shelving, and tool cases
- 5 gallon water jugs

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- Plastic film, hoses, vinyl siding, piping, or tubing
- Flower pots or other plant containers
- X Toys with metal
- X Items with circuit boards or batteries
- Items that held oil, chemicals, pesticides, or flammable liquids
- Styrofoam, packaging
