RE: Mixed Loads at Transfer Station

The Transfer Station accepts burnable materials, demolition (non-burnable) materials, metal, and miscellaneous items such as leaves and brush, electronics, fluorescent lights, batteries, and mattresses. It is imperative that each category be kept separate and placed into the proper dumpster or in the designated location. Errant items can result in the Town being fined by the disposal sites or the suspension of service. For residents bringing loads containing more than one material (mixed loads), please be aware that items must be disposed of in the correct, separate receptacles. Please pay close attention to signage and instructions from Transfer Station staff. Depending on how busy the Transfer Station is, it may not be possible to drive from one category dumpster directly to another. If items are light enough to be carried, they can be walked to the second dumpster. If it is necessary to drive the items to the second dumpster, please be aware that you may have to loop around from the deck to the check-in point and rejoin the line in order to access the second dumpster. Your cooperation, understanding, and patience are appreciated and will help to insure the Town can continue to provide this service to the residents of Southington.
