DIMENSIONS:	Sign boards are 2 feet high by 8 feet wide; 1/8 inch thickness. If you are having a sign made privately, the board material must be sturdy enough to withstand wind gusts.
DESIGN:	Allow for borders of 4 ½ inches on each side and ½ inch on the top & bottom in order to clear the holding frame. An all-white background is preferred but not mandatory. If using a pre-cut sign board obtained from the Highway/Parks Department, only paint may be used to design your sign; stick-on/vinyl letters and numbers are prohibited as the boards will be painted over & reused.
INSTALLATION:	Approved weeks run from Sunday to Saturday. Each organization is responsible for installing and removing its own sign. Signs should be inserted into the first available space. <b>DO NOT MOVE OTHER APPROVED SIGNS.</b> If there are no open spaces & you must remove a sign for an event whose time has expired, please place it on the ground
