SAFETY ALERT – NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19

The President, Governor, and the City of Stanton have declared a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19 (aka the “Coronavirus”). The Governor also issued Executive Order N-25-20 that directs Californians to follow public health directives including cancelling all large gatherings. Governor Newsom also issued Executive Order N-29-20 which lifts the strict adherence to the Brown Act regarding teleconferencing requirements and allows local legislative bodies to hold their meetings without complying with the normal requirements of in-person public participation. Pursuant to the provisions of the Governor’s Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 the October 28, 2020, Public Safety Committee Meeting will be held telephonically.

The health and well-being of our residents is the top priority for the City of Stanton and you are urged to take all appropriate health safety precautions. To that end, out of an abundance of caution the City of Stanton is eliminating in-person public participation.
