REPORT IN BRIEF:

Consideration for appointment to fill five (5) vacancies on the Stanton Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission, three (3) vacancies on the Stanton Planning Commission, and three (3) vacancies on the Stanton Public Safety Committee. There is currently a combined total of eleven (11) vacancies within the respective Commissions/Committee due to terms expired due to the November 2022 General Municipal Election. BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS:

Per City Council direction at the January 28, 2023, City Council meeting, staff was directed to call a special meeting to conduct commissioner and committee member candidate interviews and appointments if the number of commission/committee applicants was greater than ten. The City Clerk's Office received a total of sixteen applications by the stated submission deadline. One application was submitted after the publicly noticed closing period and was not included in the list of eligible applicants.

Section 2.06.030 of the Stanton Municipal Code requires the submission of applications and interviews prior to appointment to any position. Additionally, Section 2.06.030 of the Stanton Municipal Code provides that the City Council, by majority vote, may waive the interview requirement for those persons previously appointed by the City Council and who are requesting re-appointment to another term. The open recruitment process to fill eleven (11) seats on the Stanton Planning Commission, Stanton Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission, and Stanton Public Safety Committee began on January 30, 2023, and remained open to the public for two weeks, closing on February 13, 2023. Upon closing of the application process, applicants were notified and scheduled for interviews.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission consists of seven members who meet once a month. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council and City staff in matters pertaining to development/rehabilitation of parks and recreation facilities, recreation and youth services, senior citizen and human services, cultural arts services, neighborhood improvement, grants or other funding, and other matters as may be referred to the Commission by City Council from time to time.


