city manager's message



Thank you Stanton community for another fantastic summer! We hope you and your families had the opportunity to spend some quality time together enjoying the summer sun!

As summer turns to fall, be sure to browse the classes in this brochure for an array of

enriching afterschool programs and classes to keep the fun going all year long.

I also hope you've had some time to browse the City's new website, StantonCA.gov. Our goal was to create a webpage that was as user-friendly as it is visually stunning, but if you run into any issues, please send us an email at PIO@StantonCA.gov and we'd be happy to hear your suggestions.

The Community and Economic Development Department is in the process of updating the Housing Element of the General Plan. Participation from our residents is vital to ensure our community's values are identified and articulated to set the community's goals and priorities related to Housing. You can learn more and provide feedback by visiting LetsTalkStanton.com/ HousingElement.

In the fall of 2020, the City initiated a long-range plan to transform the Town Center area into a vibrant, mixed-use and pedestrian-friendly district. The first phase of community outreach and background work is complete and the results are available at LetsTalkStanton.com/TCSP for your review.

City Staff will continue to work to refine the framework plan based on community input, incorporate this information and work to draft the actual Specific Plan language. Additional engagement with the community to share updated information, refinements and checkins along the way prior to releasing the draft document for review is anticipated this fall.

As a friendly reminder, if your neighborhood participates in our permit-parking program, existing permits will expire as of December 31, 2021 and the next two-year period will be from January 1, 2022 until December 31, 2023. New permits will be available to all residents on November 1, 2021 for the following two-year cycle. Staff recommends getting permits early as parking enforcement will begin January 1, 2022. Additionally, up to 100 overnight guest permit parking passes per year can be obtained per residence at no fee from the City. Please visit StantonCA.gov/ parking for additional information.

I invite you to read through the rest of the Stanton Express to learn more about the activities our Community Services Department has in store for you this fall! We are especially happy to bring back more in-person opportunities and can't wait to see you all there!






