city manager's message



Hello Stanton residents! I hope you are enjoying our amazing spring weather and looking forward to the summer as much as I am.

In July, we'll celebrate National Parks & Recreation month and this

year's theme, Where You Belong, with a calendar full of events and activities for the whole family. Be sure to join in on the festivities with our pull-out calendar on the last page of this brochure and participate in our annual photo and drawing contests.

With the Fourth of July coming up, I'd also like to remind everyone to be safe and careful while celebrating the holiday. The use of illegal fireworks is prohibited, so please light only "safe and sane" fireworks as use of illegal fireworks is punishable by a monetary fine.

To better serve and support our local businesses, the City is working with Hinderliter de Llamas and Associates ("HdL") to streamline the City's Business License Tax Ordinance and fee structure. Recommended changes will be brought to the City Council for review at a public meeting this spring. In addition, beginning in September 2024, businesses will be able to renew their licenses completely online through HdL. Customers will experience the convenience of online services with immediate verification and renewal. HdL will also have operators standing by to support call in requests.

Our Public Works Department has been busy and the following projects are nearing completion: Cerritos Avenue Resurfacing Project, Stanton Park Adult Fitness Equipment Installation, and Stanford Storm Drain Project. Currently, projects in construction are: Premier Park Renovation Project, Family Resource Center Phase II, and FY 22/23 Citywide Street Rehabilitation. Lastly, we are in the design phase for the Sports Park, Stanton Park Refresh, Orangewood Complete Streets (which includes repairs to the Santa Rosalia Pedestrian Bridge), and the FY 23/24 Citywide Street Resurfacing Project.

Please visit StantonCA.gov/CurrentProjects for a complete list of Public Works Department projects. The Community Development Department continues to work with businesses and developers to keep development moving in the City, creating vibrant spaces to live, work, and play.

The Building Division has been conducting regular inspections of the Cloudhouse development, a 321-apartment complex with a pool and rooftop deck, with a grand opening anticipated for Fall 2024. Building permits were issued for the 79-townhome Bigsby development, which means construction will soon begin at 12210 Beach Blvd. Staff has also been busy working on the Town Center Specific Plan, focused on creating a walkable downtown along Main Street. This 30-year plan will be presented to the City Council by early Spring.

Q: How long have you been with the City?

I will be celebrating 5 years with the City of Stanton in April 2024. 4 years as a Recreation Leader and 1 year as Community Services Coordinator at the Stanton Family Resource Center.

Q: What is your day-to-day like?

Every day is different at the Stanton Family Resource Center! At the Stanton FRC, we provide services to families that include counseling, parenting classes and other family strengthening programs. I oversee the day-to-day operations at the FRC which entail services, programs and classes. I work with our Information and Referral Specialist on a daily basis to connect the community to our programs and resources. Onsite, we have a counselor, interns, and a Family Support Advocate whom the City of Stanton partners with to provide additional support to clients. Each week, we collaborate to address each family's needs and connect them to the appropriate resources they need to thrive.

Q: What is your proudest moment on the job?

After the FRC was closed for 7 months in 2023 due to renovations, one of my proudest moments was welcoming the community back onsite. Having grown up at the FRC in afterschool and volunteer programs, this building has so many memories of my childhood. I was very happy to witness its new improvements for the next generation of kids who will be growing up here. I'm grateful to be supporting families and children in my community the same way this Center supported my family. It has truly been a full-circle moment.

Q: How long have you been with the City?

I have been working for the City of Stanton for 4 years in the Public Works Department.

Q: What is your day-to-day like?

I start my day with a team meeting to discuss, plan and strategize what needs to be accomplished for the day. We review work orders as well as any pending work orders. Once the team meeting is over, I continue my day by doing SOP's (Standard Operation Procedures) on Parks since I am part of the crew maintaining them. Upon completion of SOP's, I then move on to work orders which can be put on pause unexpectedly due to other priorities. Some examples include assisting the OCSD deputies, traffic control, flood-related issues and any other emergency matters.

Q: What is your proudest moment on the job?

My proudest moment on the job was during a rainstorm that created severe flooding down Katella and Boatman. I remember the street being flooded heading Eastbound. We decided to tackle the problem by purchasing a water pump and running a water hose straight into the water channel to control the flood. It was becoming a traffic hazard by the minute, so we had to quickly set up traffic control. The next day when the rain stopped the whole crew went to try to figure out what was causing the storm drain to be clogged. Everything looked normal, but once we popped the lid, we realized it was coming from inside the sewer tunnels. My coworker George and I went inside the sewer tunnels, figured out the cause for the clog was a catch base sock which was blocking the hole. Once we figured out the problem, we were able to resolve the issue by removing the sock inside the sewer tunnel.
