**SAFETY ALERT – NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19**

The President, Governor, and the City of Stanton have declared a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19 (aka the “Coronavirus”). On September 16, 2021, Assembly Bill 361 (AB 361) was signed by Governor Newsom to allow for the Public Safety Committee to attend Committee meetings electronically/telephonically and for the public to participate in the Committee meeting by electronic means. Given the health risks associated with COVID-19 and the recent surge of the Omicron variant, state and local officials are recommending measures to promote social distancing. To that end, the Stanton Public Safety Committee will return to virtual meetings until further notice. The health and well-being of our residents and staff is the top priority for the City of Stanton, and people are urged to take all appropriate health safety precautions.
