STANTON PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMISSION VACANCY: THREE (3) SEATS

THE CITY OF STANTON CURRENTLY HAS THREE (3) UNSCHEDULED VACANCIES ON THE STANTON PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY COMMISSION.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission consists of seven members who meet on the third Monday of every month at 5:30 p.m. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission is appointed by the City Council and acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council and City staff in matters pertaining to development/rehabilitation of parks and recreation facilities, recreation and youth services, senior citizen and human services, cultural arts services, neighborhood improvement, grants or other funding, and other matters as may be referred to the Commission by City Council from time to time.

Government Code section 54974(a) requires the appointing body to post a special vacancy notice in the City Clerk's Office. The Stanton Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission seat vacancies will remain vacant until February 2025, or as soon thereafter as possible.
